Conference Themes

TOGETHER

This conference stream will look at ways in which we can collaborate, share approaches to common issues and opportunities that face our industry. It is a forum to explore better practices and leverage lessons that will allow us to transform our industry to better support people impacted by personal injury and disability. Examples of themes that presenters can submit Abstracts include, but are not limited to:

- Resilience, adaptability and responding to change
- Collaboration in a multi-stakeholder or competitive environment
- Attraction and retention of a capable workforce with capacity
- Person centered approaches: leveraging wider community supports
- Value based health care: Partnerships
- Supporting return to life and community – after injury and post scheme exit
- Health benefits of good work: operationalising within schemes

TODAY

Disruptive and challenging times over the past two years has impacted us socially, economically, technologically as we responded to the Covid-19 pandemic. This has caused our industry to rapidly adapt and change the way we operate and deliver services.

In this stream, we will discuss and learn how our industry has transformed itself, and consider contemporary issues and the opportunities to rethink the status quo. Examples of themes that presenters can submit Abstracts include, but are not limited to:

- Remote & hybrid working in a post Covid-19 world
- Resilience, adaptability and responding to change
- Person centered approaches in service delivery
- Value based health care: ensuring quality outcomes and value for money
- Customer experience
- Claims Portfolio management
- Supporting people with mental injury/harm
- Global learnings/Insights in the personal injury and disability management sector

TOMORROW

In this stream, we will look at how coming together and using today's knowledge and learnings, we can plan for a better tomorrow. We will discuss policy, governance, operational strategies, and leveraging evidence-based research to future proof this very important industry. Examples could include:

- The Future of Work
- Industry headwinds (social, economic and technological trends) - opportunities & challenges
- Scheme design: maintaining a social license & ensuring schemes remain fit for purpose
- Effective outsourcing and insourcing of claims/case management
- Research: evidence-based insights and effective translation into policy/operational practice
- Value based care: future directions
- Strategic claims management
- Injury/accident prevention
- Risk based regulation





Abstract Guidelines

LODGEMENT

All abstracts are lodged via piefconference.com. You will be asked to upload a PDF of your abstract and complete a series of questions as part of the submission process. You will also need to upload a headshot for every co-author presenting, to accompany the lodgement.

TITLE

- Title should be a maximum of 150 characters in length including spaces

AUTHOR/S

- Enter name/s of author/s on form and advise who's presenting
- Each author needs to be listed separately
- Include professional titles (e.g. Dr, Prof) when entering the author/presenter names

TEXT

- Abstracts should be a maximum of 350 words written in the English language
- Do not leave blank lines between paragraphs
- Use standard abbreviations only
- Do not use abbreviations in the title

PRESENTER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All authors will grant permission for their text, images, video and audio recordings presented at the PIEF conference to be used for the purposes of promotion and education by PIEF.
- Presentation slides will be requested in advance.
- Accepted presenters must register and pay for the conference by the date indicated by the event organisers.
- Consideration will be provided for presenters who may have limited capacity to support registration fees.
